CEBRI's 25th anniversary

On November 10, CEBRI celebrated a quarter-century of significant contributions to Brazil's international agenda. The **"25th Anniversary Seminar: where we came from and where we are going to"** held at Palácio da Cidade, in Rio de Janeiro, brought together renowned experts associated with CEBRI's history, representatives of member businesses and partners, as well as prominent figures in Brazilian politics and society. Organized with the support of **Equinor, Itaú Unibanco, Konrad Adenauer Brasil, SPIC Brasil, Suzano, TotalEnergies, FEBRABAN** and the **Rio de Janeiro City Hall**, the event revisited CEBRI's history since its inception in 1998 and also addressed contemporary topics such as sustainable development, the climate emergency, the fight against inequalities, the energy transition, the Brazilian presidency of G20 in 2024 and of COP30 in 2025, and contributed valuable insights about the future of international relations.

XX Forte International Security Conference

The Forte International Security Conference is a bi-regional dialogue forum organized by CEBRI jointly with the **Konrad Adenauer Foundation (KAS Brasil)** and the **European Union Delegation to Brazil**. This year's theme was **"The Global Order in Transformation: navigating the Perfect Storm"**. This annual event brings together decision-makers, diplomats, representatives of the military and scholars from Latin America and Europe to foster debate focusing on a just and peaceful international order. In its 20-year history, the Conference has facilitated a large number of significant debates, as well as the consolidation of an international network of experts, authorities and Brazilian and international leaders. In 2023, CEBRI International Advisory Board Member **Ambassador Marcos Caramuru** served as Co-Chair of Task Force 1 “Macroeconomics, Trade, and Livelihoods: Policy Coherence and International Coordination” of Think20 (T20), organized in India by the Observer Research Foundation (ORF).



On November 25, CEBRI, the **Institute for Applied Economic Research (IPEA)** and the **Alexandre de Gusmão Foundation (FUNAG)**, organizations that make up the Think 20 Brasil Organizing Committee, assumed the position of Think20 (T20) coordinators. The coordination baton of one of the G20 Engagement Groups passed from India to Brazil in a ceremony in South Africa with the presence of CEBRI Trustee Emeritus and Brazil’s former Minister for the Environment and for Climate Change (2010-2016) Izabella Teixeira and of CEBRI Director of Projects Luciana Gama Muniz.

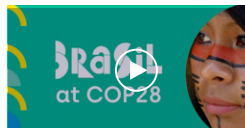

COP28 & CEBRI

This year, CEBRI was present at the **28th Conference of the Parties to the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (COP 28)** in Dubai, United Arab Emirates. CEBRI experts and associated researchers contributed with the debate in panel “G20 and the Sustainability Agenda” and participated in discussions through the CIPÓ Platform together with ApexBrasil and the Climate and Society Institute (ICS). The panels took place at the Brazil Pavilion, a COP28 national area led by the federal government, and brought together scientists, diplomats and government leaders from around the world.

On December 14 and 15, CEBRI sponsored the event “**COP28 Review**” and a working lunch of the Board of Trustees to review the result of those discussions and the findings in the final Conference document. The meeting at Casa Zalszupin, in São Paulo, included the presence of CEBRI founder Celso Lafer, CEBRI CEO Julia Dias Leite, CEBRI Trustee Emeritus Izabella Teixeira, Arapyáú Institute Executive Director Renata Piazzon and CEBRI Senior Fellow Mônica Sodré. The CEBRI Board of Trustees meeting in Rio de Janeiro included the presence of Ana Toni, Clarissa Lins and Ilona Szabó.

In June, the event “**Brazil Talks with the World: Amazon Summit, G20, COP Dubai and COP 30 in Brazil**”, at Casa Zalszupin, discussed Brazil’s climate agenda for the coming years. In the meeting, participants from government, civil society and the private sector offered their insights on sustainability and the environment.



On December 14, the event “**Conversation with Raul Jungmann about Public Security in Brazil**”, organized in partnership with Casa Zalszupin, featured a lecture by IBRAM CEO, former Special Minister for Public Security (2018-2019) and former Minister of Defense of Brazil (2016-2018) Raul Jungmann. The event was moderated by CEBRI Trustee Emeritus and former Minister of Finance (1995 - 2002) Pedro Malan.

The event “**COP28 Review**” subsequently discussed the key results of the 28th Conference of the Parties to the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (COP 28) and Brazil’s participation in the debate.
